State Office, all community service projects which you have been involved with throughout the year of 2022 after State Finals, through 2023, along with your completed essay of "What Does Louisiana Kids, Inc. Mean To Me". All community service hours must be accompanied by a contact name and phone number for verification purposes. You must also turn in a copy of your current "Third Quarter" school report card, which should include your third semester grades. Any special awards or recognition you have received should also be sent in for consideration. All qualified members who have met the above criteria will be contacted to vote for our very special Louisiana Kids, Inc. Choice Award, which will be presented at State Finals.

7. Extra curricular Activities & Interests.
8. Volunteer Service.
9. Honors and Achievements.
10. Employment Record, Include Summer, Part, & Full-Time Employment.

A letter of acceptance from the College or University of your choice.

IF ALL FORMS ARE NOT RECEIVED AT THE SAME TIME, YOU WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR ANY SPECIAL AWARDS AND/OR SCHOLARSHIPS. WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY INFORMATION VIA ANY FORM OF ELECTRONIC MAIL. HARD COPIES MUST BE ENCLOSED WITH COMPLETED PACKAGE ONLY.

Registration will consist of the following:

ONCE CONTACTING THE STATE OFFICE PLEASE SEND VIA E-MAIL louisianakids@gmail.com AND ATTACH AS A MP3 FILE ONCE YOU RECEIVE YOUR ACT NUMBER. PLEASE NAME EACH FILE USING THE ACT #, PERFORMER NAME, AND NAME OF ACT.**

NOTEONLY ONE SONG PER PERFORMANCE MP3 OR TRACK**ANY TRACKS TURNED IN WITH MORE THAN ONE SONG ON TRACK WILL HAVE A ONE POINT DEDUCTION FROM THEIR FINAL SCORE. IF ANY TRACKS GO OVER THREE MINUTES AND 15 SECONDS, THERE WILL BE ONE POINT DEDUCTED FOR EVERY 15 SECONDS, OR A PORTION OF, OVER THE TIME LIMITS.**

3. Verify technical information sheet. – Pre-Registration Only
4. Verify emcee card information. – Pre-Registration Only
5. Order photos & videos. ** To protect the integrity of each act, no one will be allowed to take photos or videos during the competition. – Forms will be e-mailed prior to Event.
6. "KEEP PROPS TO A **Minimum**, LESS IS BEST." - Day of Event.

For this year's State Finals, there will be changes in regards to props. An act representative is responsible for placing all props for the performance on stage at State Finals. Louisiana Kids, Inc. will no longer provide stagehands to place props for acts. All solo and group acts have one minute to set up **AND** take off props, and all production numbers have two minutes.

All members are responsible to remove any and all stage props from the facility or it's grounds immediately following the event. If props are part of a Studio group act, the Studio Affiliate is responsible to remove the props.

7. Receive Program book which will contain act sequence of performance. – Day of Event.

For this year's State Finals, act sequence will not change under any circumstances nor to accommodate anyone's schedule. Once the line-up has been created, it will remain as is – no exceptions.

Program books purchased day of event will be \$10.00 each. You have already purchased your Program book at this state event, and your copy is reserved. Our Program books will contain performing act sequence and Schedule of Events, Awards to be presented, and Louisiana Kids Essays Contest "Words From The Heart".

For this year's State Finals, there will also be a limit of 4 headsets per act (including production numbers).

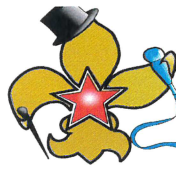

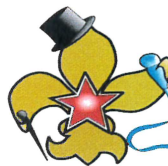

(4) If any Major Talent Category has 1 to 8 acts entered, then the cash prize will be given at the 15% level.

Those who receive the Grand Champion Awards will not be given the Sub-Talent Category award as they will have been promoted 'up' into the Grand Champion Category.

(1) If any Sub-Talent Category has less than 20 acts or more than 10 entered the cash prize will be given at the 50% level (2) If any Sub-Talent Category has 1 to 9 acts entered the cash prize will be given at the 25% level.
